Subject: **Occupational Health and Safety Report – 2nd Quarter 2011**

Summary:

As indicated in the chart below, for the months April, May and June 2011 there was 4 first aid incidents which required on site attention by Exhibition Place staff (i.e. bandage for small cuts) and three recordable medical aid incidents which required attention by a physician at a hospital or doctor's office. There was one lost time injury.

Financial Implications:

There are no financial implications to this report.

Decision History:

As part of the 2009 Strategic Plan, the Board approved a Safety and Security Goal to *Ensure a safe and secure environment for employees, guests and for our property and our assets.*

Issue Background:

Pursuant to the *Occupation Health & Safety Act*, section 25(1) and 26(1), the Board as the employer is responsible for taking every precaution reasonable for the safety of the workers. Also, as a local board of a municipality, the Board is a Schedule II employer for the purposes of workers compensation.

Comments:

As indicated below, for the months April, May and June 2011 there was: four first aid incidents; three recordable medical aid incidents and one lost time injury.


