

The provisions of the “Relationship Framework” between the City of Toronto and the Exhibition Place stipulate that the Board comply with the following provisions of the *City of Toronto Act*.

Lobby Registry

In accordance with subsection of 165(1) of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* the City will establish and maintain a Lobbyist Registry that retains information by persons who lobby public office holders. Public office holders include Board Members and Board staff.

Persons or entities who lobby public office holders will be required to comply with the City’s Lobbyist Registry and any associated policies or codes as adopted by Council and as amended from time to time.

Persons or entities in an existing contractual relationship with the Board will not be considered to be engaged in lobbying activity where they communicate with staff or Board members on matters relating to the subject-matter or administration of such contracts.

Ombudsman

The function of the City’s Ombudsman is to investigate any decision or recommendation made or any act done or omitted in the course of the administration of the City, its local boards (restricted definition) and such city-controlled corporations as Council may specify and affecting any person or body of persons in his, her, or its personal capacity.

Section 19 of the *Ombudsman Act* applies to the exercise of powers and the performance of duties of the Ombudsman. In accordance with subsection 19(1) of that Act, upon request, the Board shall provide the Ombudsman with information related to any matter he or she is investigating.

The Ombudsman and every person acting under the instructions of the Ombudsman shall preserve secrecy with respect to all matters in the course of his or her duties as required under subsection 173(1) of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*.
