Subject: **Occupational Health and Safety Report – 1st Quarter 2011**

Summary:

As indicated in the chart below, for the months January, February and March 2011 there was one first aid incident which required on site attention by Exhibition Place staff (i.e. bandage for small cuts) and one recordable medical aid incident which required attention by a physician at a hospital or doctor's office. There were two lost time injuries.

Financial Implications:

There are no financial implications to this report.

Decision History:

As part of the 2009 Strategic Plan, the Board approved a Safety and Security Goal to *Ensure a safe and secure environment for employees, guests and for our property and our assets.*

Issue Background:

Pursuant to the *Occupation Health & Safety Act*, section 25(1) and 26(1), the Board as the employer is responsible for taking every precaution reasonable for the safety of the workers. Also, as a local board of a municipality, the Board is a Schedule II employer for the purposes of workers compensation.

Comments:

As indicated below, for the months January, February and March 2011 there was: one first aid incident; one recordable medical aid incidents and two lost time injuries.

- severity (# of days lost X 200,000 / total hours worked)


