Subject: Parking Rate Adjustment

Summary:

This report seeks approval to increase daily regular and exhibitor parking rates by \$1. An annual review of parking rates shows that with the \$1 increase, Exhibition Place rates will remain competitive in the marketplace. The \$1 rate increase is necessary to meet proposed 2017 budget objectives. Due to the construction on the grounds, parking rates have not increased since 2013 for Tenants, Exhibitors and Regular Rates.

This report also seeks the Board's approval to increase monthly parking pass rates which have not increased for many years and the increase proposed is in keeping with the monthly parking rates charged by Toronto Parking Authority in Liberty Village.

Recommendations:

It is recommended that the Board approve adjustments in Parking Rates at Exhibition Place as follows:

- 1) Proposed Regular and Peak Day Parking Rates at Exhibition Place increase by \$1;
- 2) Proposed Monthly Parking Pass Rates at Exhibition Place increase by \$40 per month; and
- 3) That the price increase recommended in items 1 & 2 above and as shown in Appendix "C" be implemented on January 1, 2017.

Financial Impact:

The \$1 per day increase in regular and exhibitor parking rates recommended in item 1 above will result in an increase of approximately \$360,000 in Board revenue in 2017. The proposed 2017 Operating Budget was drafted to include this increased amount.

<u>Decision History:</u>

The Exhibition Place 2014-2016 Strategic Plan had a Financial Goal to maintain a positive operating financial performance across Exhibition Place and all its businesses and as a strategy to support this goal we will seek new and / or expand revenue opportunities within our existing operations.

At its meeting of February 12, 2016 the Board approved a recommendation directing staff to report to the Finance & Audit Committee on the Parking Rate structure for events at Exhibition Place.

At its meeting of May 22, 2015 the Board approved an increase in the Special Event Rate up to a maximum of \$30 effective May 23, 2015.

At its meeting of April 12, 2013 the Board approved that Exhibition Place would hold the Parking rates for 2 years during the hotel construction in 2013 and 2014 and that no parking rate increase be implemented until after the hotel opens in 2015.

At its meeting of November 4, 2011 the Board approved a \$1 increase in the regular daily and evening rates in all lots, bringing the daily rate to \$14, and evening rate to \$11, effective April, 2012. Issue Background:

Parking rates are reviewed annually and set at a level that will ensure an adequate supply of spaces for shows and events, cover the cost of operating the spaces and contribute towards general operating costs, while remaining competitive in the marketplace and conducive to attracting and retaining business at Exhibition Place.

The Finance & Audit Committee were scheduled to meet on Monday, August 29, 2016 to consider subject report, however, the meeting was cancelled for lack of quorum. The Chair of the Finance & Audit Committee directed that this matter be submitted directly to the Board given the 2017 Parking Rate Adjustment needed to be implemented in time for the 2017 show season and as part of the 2017 Operating Budget deliberations.

Comments:

WSP reviewed the Parking Rates as part of the recent overall Parking Study and had concluded that Exhibition Place in 2015 was generally in line with rates; however, recommended substantial investments / improvements to the lots which are now built into the Board's 10-year Capital Program and also within its 2016 and 2017 Operating Budgets. In addition, the WSP report recommended that Exhibition Place (a) develop parking rates that reflect location of event, current market and off-site events and competitors; and (b) develop / adopt parking rates that help to manage parking and traffic on site. Both these directions have been addressed in this report and in the recommendations above.

While the major clients on the grounds have expressed their concerns about the diminishing parking supply although in its report, WSP concluded that the "parking supply of approximately 6,000 spaces on Exhibition Place is adequate" to service current demand. However, over 2016, Exhibition Place staff will have or be taking several initiatives / capital upgrades to increase the parking supply on the grounds which are as follows:

- Removal of storage items and dirt from Lot P creating 214 spaces and adding new lighting and emergency call stations
- Nunavut Road straightening for Lot 3 creating 52 spaces
- Removal of storage shed in Lot 4 creating 68 spaces
- Opening of underground (unlimited / not reserved) parking spots at Hotel X creating 400 spaces

With all these upgrades, the supply of parking at Exhibition Place will increase from 5,721 (2013) to 6,455 (2016/17).

Finally, Exhibition Place staff have just completed an annual review of parking rates in the nearby lots as studied by WSP in 2015 and shown on Appendix A. This updated study indicates that rates in the marketplace have increased by \$1 to \$3 per day. Since 2015, parking rates at

the Metro Toronto Convention Centre have increased by \$3 (now \$30 per day), and prepaid Exhibitor rates have increased to \$18 per day. However, parking continues to be advertised as free at the Toronto Congress Centre and the International Centre in Mississauga.

Appendix B attached to this report has the full list of existing and proposed rates across Exhibition Place. The Existing regular daily rates are \$14 (\$11 after 6pm) and prepaid Exhibitor parking passes for outside lots are \$9 per day. This report is recommending the following increases:

- Increase of a \$1 per day in regular, exhibitor and west end tenant parking.
- No change to the practice that on select busy show dates, the regular daily rate in the Enercare Centre parking garage is increased to \$15 to help redistribute cars between the garage and outdoor lots.
- Increase Monthly parking permits for Lot #6 by \$40 per month to align more with market rates in the TPA lots in the surrounding area.
- No change to the special event rates of up to \$30 for events such as Honda Indy, Caribbean Carnival and Ontario Place events.

Exhibition Place staff have met with the Tenants to advise them of the proposed increase. Staff will be reporting back to the Board Finance & Audit Committee in October 2016 on the matter of the future construction of a structured garage. Exhibition Place also continues to work with the Toronto Parking Authority (TPA) on other initiatives regarding Green P on-line and automated payments and other matters.
