Of 9 recommendations, we expect 8 to be complete by mid-2016:

Long-Term Opportunities

Of 8 recommendations, we expect 3 to be complete by mid-2016:

- Develop a joint collective bargaining strategy
- Change management centre of excellence
- Include the agencies in a plan to transition to managing digital records
