Subject: **Occupational Health and Safety Report –2nd Quarter 2013**

Summary:

As indicated in the chart below, for the three months ending June 30, 2013 there were 4 first aid incidents which required on site attention by Exhibition Place staff (i.e. bandage for small cuts) and 2 recordable medical aid incidents which required attention by a physician at a hospital or doctor's office and no lost time injuries.

Financial Implications:

There are no financial implications to this report.

Decision History:

The Exhibition Place 2012 - 2015 Strategic Plan had a Safety and Security Goal *To promote safe work practices for all staff* and as a Strategy to support this Goal we will *implement programs and procedures designed to reduce instances/eliminate opportunities for injuries*.

Issue Background:

Pursuant to the *Occupation Health & Safety Act*, section 25(1) and 26(1), the Board as the employer is responsible for taking every precaution reasonable for the safety of the workers. Also, as a local board of a municipality, the Board is a Schedule II employer for the purposes of workers compensation.

Comments:

As indicated below, for the months April, May, and June of 2013 there were: 4 first aid incidents; 4 recordable medical aid incidents and 1 lost time injury. Outside of those statistics, there were a total of 22 near miss incidences that could have resulted in an accident, however were reported and corrected where appropriate.

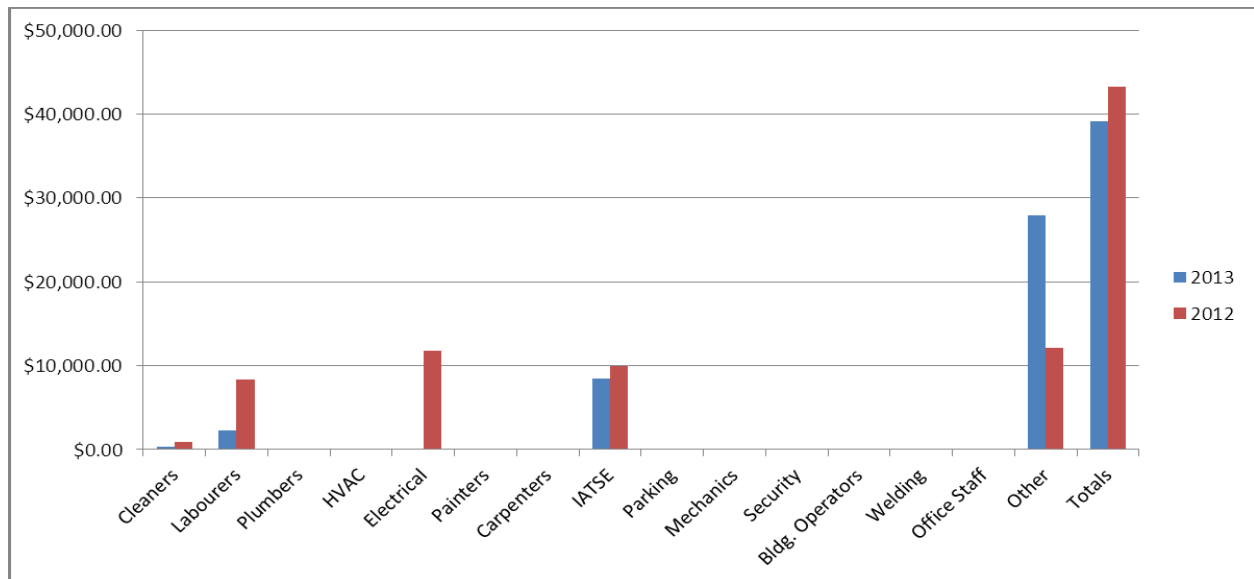
