Eamonn O’Loghlin was born in Ennistymon, County Clare, Republic of Ireland on September 7, 1951 and was the beloved husband of Madeleine for 37 years, the loving father of Treasa (Edward Pendergrast) and Rory, and the adored son-in-law of Eleanor Treacy. His family was very important to him – all one had to do was listen to hear the pride in his voice as he spoke about his devoted wife, Madeleine, and his adoring children, Treasa and Rory, all of whom he loved deeply.

Eamonn was Director of Strategic Partnerships and Corporate Sponsorship at the Canadian National Exhibition for over a decade, and also provided sponsorship services to Exhibition Place.

Eamonn was larger than life, with a personality to match, which virtually filled any room he walked in to. He was never afraid to speak his mind, to say what he thought was right and needed to be said.
