

With all of the changes outlined in the new Collective Agreement between Exhibition Place and IATSE Local 58, we wanted to give you a cheat sheet to help you quickly identify how these changes will positively affect your next event at Exhibition Place!

Hours of work

No more arbitrary premium days. The new work week = Monday – Sunday

- regular time = 7AM–12AM for the first 8 hrs
- 8+ hrs or between 12AM–7AM = rate of pay x1.5/hr
- 12+ hrs = rate of pay x2/hr
- day 6 & 7 (after 5 straight days of work) = rate of pay x1.5/hr



New minimum call requirements based on our lines of business

- 4 hrs = when work is scheduled at premium time
- 4 hrs = when employees are scheduled for more than one call in a day, or
- 5 hrs = that permits work to be scheduled on multiple activities within one event



Recording your events

You can capture content from your event, with limited restrictions by:

- using your video production equipment for your archives or broadcast over an internet based environment
- traditional media coverage



DJs, Single Person Setups, Musicians and Plug and Play Technology

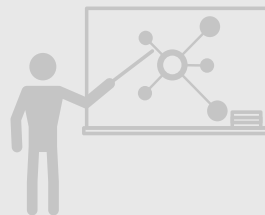
Your DJ, single person setups or musicians can operate with:

- a small, self-contained set-up that doesn't require a substantial configuration



Plug and play presentations

Set-up and run your own PowerPoint presentation through existing house systems.



No more job shadowing and the use of 3rd-party operators

Business function and travelling events can now use their own operator positions for defined lines of business in combination with IATSE Local 58:



- lighting
- FOH sound
- multi-media
- video
