Canada's Sports Hall of Fame for the 2001 Term

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board appoint two members, representing Exhibition Place, and Councillor Doug Holyday, representing the CNEA to the Canada's Sport Hall of Fame (CSHF) for the 2001 term.

Background:

In accordance with the by-laws of the CSHF, its Board shall include three representatives (two from the Board of Governors and one from the CNEA Board) appointed by the Board of Governors of Exhibition Place.

By resolution of the Board of Governors, one of the representatives appointed to the above Board shall be nominated by the CNEA. At its meeting of November 9, 2000, the Board of Directors of the CNEA nominated Councillor Doug Holyday for appointment to the CSHF for a term expiring on the date of the Annual Meeting of the Association to be held October 2001, and until his successor is appointed.

Discussion:

The Board's representatives to the CSHF in 2000 were Fernando do Rio, Sean Webster and Councillor Doug Holyday.
