Attached is the Year-End Report regarding the 2000 Capital Works Program of Exhibition Place. In summary, the total Capital Works Program Budget for 2000 was \$4,245,000 with total maximum projected expenditure at \$4,047,102 and a total minimum projected surplus of \$197,898, all excluding G.S.T. However, the Board at its October 2000 meeting approved to purchase additional parking control equipment up to \$200,000 from the total surplus of the 2000 program.
