**CNE Red Convertible** 

## Recommendation:

It is recommended that this report be received for information.

## Background:

At the Board meeting of May 25, 2001, the CNEA President requested that staff report on the history of the Red Convertible (CNE001) and the costs to make it roadworthy for use in special events.

#### Discussion:

In 1975 the Canadian National Exhibition Association purchased a red GrandVille Pontiac Convertible which was used during the downtown CNEA "Opening" parades and the daily ones on the grounds, until both were stopped due to budget reasons. It was also used by the Toronto Argonauts for the 1991 Grey Cup Parade.

During the off-season months, the convertible is kept in the Firehall and prior to the opening of the CNE, it is moved to the Garage outside the General Services Building and used for the Opening Day Ceremony.

The vehicle is listed on the Exhibition Place preventative maintenance schedule and is checked twice a year for battery charging, oil changes and is test driven to ensure the brakes are functioning normally.

Detailed below is the approximate cost (including parts and in-house labour) to recondition the convertible.

# Total approximate cost of parts and in-house labour is \$10,778.89.

# Conclusion:

This report outlines the required repairs to the CNE001 vehicle. As the estimate exceeds \$10,000, a decision to proceed would require that a bid procedure be undertaken with the City of Toronto Purchasing Department.

Should the Board wish staff to pursue these repairs, the appropriate approvals would be required through either the CNEA Board of Directors or possibly the Directors of the CNE Foundation, given that the vehicle is a CNEA property.
