Attached is the Year-End Report regarding the 2001 Capital Works Program of Exhibition Place. In summary, the total Capital Works Program Budget for 2001 was \$2,400,000 excluding the Automotive Building Air Conditioning project of \$1,250,000. Total actual expenditure to date is at \$2,308,045 with a total surplus of \$91,955, all excluding G.S.T. Three projects with a total of \$123,000, are recommended to be carried forward to 2002.
