

# Overnight weekend construction at Exhibition Station

Starting on Friday, December 1 at 10 p.m. until Monday, December 4, 2023 at 5 a.m.



### What is happening?

- Track relocation work will take place within the Lakeshore West GO rail corridor at Exhibition Station starting at 10 p.m. on Friday, December 1, until 5 a.m. on Monday, December 4, 2023.
- The existing westbound track will be relocated further north to align with the station's new temporary passenger platform (outlined in purple on the map above).
- For safety, train service in the rail corridor will be shut down over the weekend while track relocation work takes place.
- Construction activities will include rail cutting, welding, compacting, grading, concrete and installation of wooden ties and track rail.
- Continued work (structural, miscellaneous steel, roofing) will be performed at the new head house at 1 Atlantic Ave.
- Construction will take place during the day and overnight throughout the weekend to ensure all necessary activities are completed during the rail closure.
- To minimize noise disruption, crews will limit loud activities, such as rail cutting, during the overnight period. Approximately 525 metres of rail will be built before the weekend to expedite installation and to reduce noise.
- Starting Monday December 4, 2023, GO train passengers will be required to use the new pedestrian platform to board westbound trains. Minor pedestrian route changes will be in effect. Please review the map and pedestrian details section below for further details.

### Traffic and pedestrian details

- Starting Monday, December 4, 2023, the old pedestrian platform located west of the Exhibition Station entrance will be closed.
- Pedestrians will be required to use the new pedestrian platform located east of the station entrance to board westbound trains.
- Pedestrian access to Exhibition Station will be maintained via Atlantic Ave.

#### What to expect

- Saws, excavators, loaders, skid-steerers, rollers, torches, dump trucks, and other hand tools will be used to facilitate the work.
- Expect noise from the construction equipment specified above.
- Approximately 800 metres of track will be moved over the weekend.
- During a previous rail corridor closure, the old GO headhouse was demolished. During this weekend closure (December 1 December 4, 2023) this area including a decommissioned staircase, will be filled with concrete.
- Site lighting will be positioned downward into the rail corridor and away from residential properties.
- Clear signage will be posted to direct pedestrians.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- Traffic control personnel and/or a paid duty officer will be present while this work takes place.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

### **Transit information**

 There will be service adjustments on the Lakeshore West Line starting at 10 p.m. on Friday, December 1, until end of service on Sunday December 3, 2023. GO buses will replace some train service during this time. For more information on GO service impacts, please visit
